Dear Pastor and Church Family:

Olkeri

As was mentioned in the last letter, there are several churches within one kilometer of our church plant; however, not one of these churches preaches or teaches the Gospel of Christ without adding to the requirements of salvation. This means that everyone we encounter during our evangelism is “saved.” A brief conversation with them reveals the false doctrine that they have accepted as truth. Our great work in Olkeri is to show people from God’s Word what He says about the matter of their salvation. As we cannot force anyone to be saved, we depend on the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts of the people to convince them of their need of salvation.

This week, I met Mary. She is an older lady who was sitting outside her home when I and one of our Bible institute students came up to her home. Once she learned that we were from a church, she took the time to share with us her burdens. To summarize, Mary complained of not sleeping well due to demonic oppression. Before we left, I prayed with Mary asking the Lord to show the truth of God’s Word to her that she may come to know spiritual freedom. We made plans with Mary to stop by for another visit next time we are on evangelism. Please pray for Mary that the Lord would work on her heart in the matter of her salvation and spiritual freedom from the oppression that she is under. This week was a reminder that there is a spiritual warfare being waged in Olkeri. We are depending upon the Lord to accomplish His will in setting people free from their bondage to sin. Please pray for us as we labor in Olkeri.
